COVID19 – Safety Plan

The AIDA NSW State Championships 2021, held at West HQ (Rooty Hill RSL), 33 Railway St, Rooty Hill will be held in accordance with Government regulations ensuring safety for our staff and course attendees.

The 2sq metre restriction on attendee numbers will be in place to ensure our venue remains within its limited capacity.

Only participants and TWO accompanying adults/family members will be allowed entry into the Hall. No exceptions will be made.

All attendees 12 years and over will be required to wear masks at all times when inside the venue. Dancers will not be required to wear them whilst on stage.

All attendees must check in using the QR code at the door.

Social distancing will be expected from all who attend at all times. This will include the dancers during marshalling and presentations.

We will have Sanitizing bottles available for use and ask that all personnel wash your hands with soap and/or sanitise your hands regularly.

Dancers will only be allowed access to the hall and warm up areas during their designated session time. This time will be limited so all dancers must arrive ready to dance with Hair and make up done, there will be no available space within the club to undertake these tasks.

Further to this dancers are encouraged not to share things such as sock glue or make up.

Please follow all directions and signage at the venue.

There will be separate entry and exit points.

Participants will be required to leave the premises immediately once the Presentation is completed.

The auditorium will be cleaned between sessions.

Appointed Covid Marshalls will be present during the event and if at any time you are found to not be obeying the Covid Guidelines in place you will be ejected from the venue.

Do not attend if you or anyone in your household is are unwell for any reason, if you or someone with whom you had contact with has a known or suspected case on COVID-19 even if you are asymptomatic, or:

- have been asked by someone else to self-isolate
- have any cold or flu-like symptoms
